

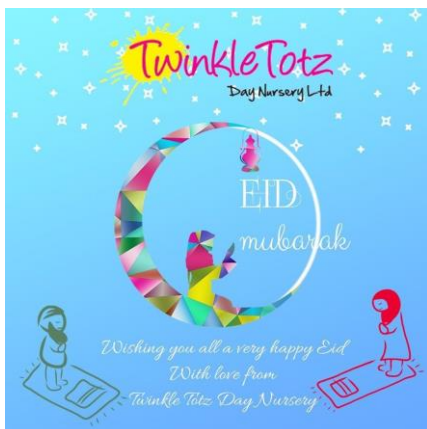

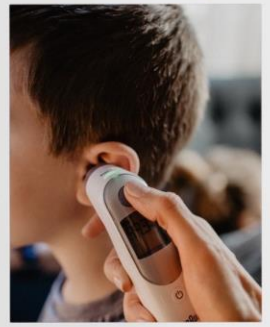

How are we keeping Children & families Safe

From Covid-19 at Twinkle Totz

We are proud that some of our nurseries have stayed open during this time to support the lifesaving effort of soo many of our Key Workers and to support our vulnerable families. As we prepare to ease lockdown and re-open the rest of our nurseries to welcome you all back, we want to let you know what we are doing to keep you all safe.

We will NOT be permitting anyone in the nursery who is showing ANY symptoms of the Corona Virus. Please do not attend the nursery and stay at home to self isolate if you or anyone in your household has a high temperature or develops a new and continuous cough.



1. On arrival we will be taking the temperature of all staff, children and visitors of the nursery
2. All parents/ carers are to wait outside during drop off and pick up times until they are welcomed in individually, maintaining social distancing and being mindful of other users of the centre
3. Footprints have been marked on the floors to maintain and act as a guideline to keep a minimum of 2m distance
4. All parents/carers will be asked to wash their child's hands upon drop off and collection
5. Parents are required to use their own pen to sign in
6. All staff will be required to wear PPE, in the event that children are distressed upon handover from parents staff will be wearing a mask, apron and gloves
7. We will be monitoring all staff and children's health throughout the day, checking their temperature and washing hands with warm soap and water whilst singing some new songs
8. In any event that a child feels unwell, displaying symptoms of a cough or has a high temperature, parents will be informed immediately and will be required to pick their child up
9. All malleable play such as play dough, sand and water, has been removed to prevent cross contamination
10. We already have a structured and robust cleaning system for infection control within Early Years and have built on these practices for the current situation
11. We have a structured cleaning procedure and are using a sterilising solution that has anti-viral properties
